

UGI INTERCONNECTION APPLICATION FEES
(For Interconnection Applications filed under §§75.21 – 75.51)

Level 1 Review

There is a One Hundred dollar (\$100) non-refundable application fee for a Level 1 interconnection review. However, if an application for a Level 1 interconnection review is denied because it does not meet the requirements for a Level 1 interconnection review, and the applicant resubmits the application under another review procedure in accordance with the Commission Regulations, UGI will apply the Level 1 application fee toward the application fee for the resubmitted application.

Level 2 Review

There is a Two Hundred and Fifty dollar (\$250) application fee for a Level 2 interconnection review plus One dollar (\$1) per kilowatt of the customer-generator facility's nameplate capacity, plus the cost of any minor modifications to the electric distribution system or additional review, permitted under the regulations. Costs for such minor modifications or additional review shall be based on UGI estimates and shall be subject to review by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at the request of either party. Costs for engineering work done as part of any additional review will not exceed \$100 per hour and will be based on UGI's average fully loaded engineering labor rate. All fees and costs are non-refundable, however, if an application for a Level 2 interconnection review is denied because it does not meet the requirements for a Level 2 interconnection review, and the applicant resubmits the application under another review procedure in accordance with the Commission Regulations, UGI will apply the Level 2 application fees toward the application fees for the resubmitted application.

Level 3 Review

There is a Three Hundred and Fifty dollar (\$350) application fee for a Level 3 interconnection review plus Two dollar (\$2) per kilowatt of the customer-generator facility's nameplate capacity, plus the cost of any feasibility studies, system impact studies or facilities studies required. Costs for engineering work done as part of a feasibility study, system impact study or facility study will not exceed \$100 per hour. If UGI must install facilities in order to accommodate the interconnection of the Customer-generator facility, the cost of such facilities shall be the responsibility of the Customer-generator. All fees and costs are non-refundable, however, if an application for a Level 3

interconnection review is denied because it does not meet the requirements for a Level 3 interconnection review, and the applicant resubmits the application under another review procedure in accordance with the Commission Regulations, UGI will apply the Level 3 application fees toward the application fees for the resubmitted application.

Level 4 Review

In those instances when a Level 4 application is processed using the Level 1, Level 2, or Level 3 review process, the fees set forth for those particular review levels will apply. A Level 4 application reviewed under § 75.40(d) will be subject to a non-refundable base application fee of Three Hundred and Fifty dollar (\$350) plus Two dollar (\$2) per kilowatt of the customer-generator facility's nameplate capacity. No fee will be assessed for an area network impact study conducted under §75.40. If an application for a Level 4 interconnection review is denied because it does not meet the requirements for a Level 4 interconnection review, and the applicant resubmits the application under another review procedure in accordance with the Commission Regulations, UGI will apply the Level 4 application fees toward the application fees for the resubmitted application.
